We have a lot to be thankful for. God has continued to use us in different ways during this COVID time as it has thrown our ministry plans off schedule. Of course, our schedule isn't important when God has other plans for us. We are at peace with that and are following His lead through this uncertain time in everyone's life.

Steve has been very active as missions pastor at our sending church. We are thankful that tonight a young couple that has been overseas in a high security area will be landing soon to spend some time in the states before going back. We would love to share details, but are limited in what we can share about that. Just know that God has been at work in this couple's life and in the lives of those around them. Steve is playing a support role to them from our church since we are from the same sending church.

We've written about John and Fabiana Nascimento who are Brazilian missionaries in the country of Guyana. We are partnering with them and have

visited them in the country of Guyana before. We've had plans that have had to be cancelled due to COVID, and now again due to this news. In April it was found that Fabi has cancer. Due to the very poor and limited health care available, she didn't get the results of her biopsy for 2 months, when it was supposed to be 2 weeks. Those just came in and we heard from John that it is not good news. They need to return to Brasil urgently to get treatment for Fabi. But when John was looking up ticket prices, he found that it will cost more than \$6000 just for one ticket. John is considering seeing if God will provide that amount for Fabi to go be with her parents next week to get started on treatment ASAP, while he and their 3 young sons go to Brasil as soon as they are able to. We are praying for them and we ask that you join us in praying for them too. We know that God has a plan that he will provide for, and we are watching eagerly to see how He does what only He can do.

We have another prayer request for our administrator and friend, Cal Clark. He has been battling pancreatic cancer since June of 2020. This last two weeks have been an especially difficult and painful struggle. Please pray with us that Mayo Clinic might have some treatment to ease his suffering and possibly even dial back the cancer with new and promising treatments. We know God is able if it is His will.

Our third and final prayer request is for a trip we are asking God to allow us to take in September. We are praying that the trip to Southern Brasil we had to cancel in March and then again in May will be one we can take in September. God knows the answer and we only want what He wants. Thank you in advance for praying concerning that trip.

On a family note- Our daughter is getting married next month and we are all excited about it. It should be a beautiful wedding and celebration. We praise God for the young man she's going to marry and for his commitment to walking with Jesus.

Thank you for praying for us, for supporting our ministry and for being an
